

Tennis Court Reservation Rules

- Members may book a court 4 days in advance beginning at 7:00 am. Members may book online at https://cacabac.clubautomation.com/, using the Avila Bay Club app, by calling 805-595-7600 ex 100, or in person at the club.
- Court times are 1 hour and 30 minutes. A member may reserve no more than one court at a time, and with at least one hour in between reservations.
- The person reserving must give first and last names for 2 for singles and 4 for doubles, at the time of reservation. If you have an unknown player, you can choose the name "Guest Placeholder" to hold the spot and it can be filled in as you find out the proper name.
- If you are not able to play during the reservation time that you have scheduled, we kindly ask that you cancel your court at least 2 hours prior to your reservation. ABAC reserves the right to charge each person on the reservation a \$10 no-show fee. If the court reservation players do not arrive within 15 minutes of the assigned court time and do not call ahead to alert the staff, the court will be released and open to members to book.
- Rain Delays: If there is inclement weather, staff will determine if the courts should be rolled by
 observing two different weather radar systems. The tennis webcam is available on our website 24
 hours a day, and will show you if courts are wet and are being rolled yet. If courts are wet, your
 reservation is voided and you will need to re-book a new court time.
- Court time begins at the time of your reservation (not when you enter the court). Please relinquish your court when your time is up. If you are in the middle of a point, finish that one point only. Do not attempt to finish the game. It is important to quickly exit the court as the next reservation has now begun. Those waiting, please open the gate and advise that time is up and give them a minute or two to finish the point. Both parties are expected to be courteous and accommodating.
- Court reservations for CCWTL or USTA league team play should be made in advance by the team
 captain, directly with the tennis director by emailing michael@avilabayclub.com. Please make sure
 these reservations have been communicated at least a week in advance in order to have the courts
 reserved.
- Only Avila Bay Club tennis staff are allowed to instruct tennis on the courts. Family members teaching each other are excluded from this rule.

BALL MACHINE: Reservations for the ball machine must be reserved by calling 805-595-7600 ex 100, or in person at the club, to ensure availability of the machine and an accessible court. The ball machine can be used on courts 6 or 7 only. The ball machine may be reserved 24 hours in advance.

We ask that you please be kind to each other. Please remember that we are a family club and that it is our desire for everyone to feel welcome and have the opportunity to enjoy the tennis courts.
